 bell and Denoted in a plan of the said Town by the Figures No. 5 and  
 No. 6 Containing One Square Acre and No. 8. and No. 45 Containing  
 by Estimation five Acres and a half - of more or less, Together with all their  
 Appertainances To have and to hold the said Granted Lots or par-  
 cels of Land with all their Appertainances to the same belonging with the  
 Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders every part and a  
 Parcel thereof unto the said James Buford his heirs and Assigns forever  
 and the said John Mead and Elizabeth his Wife doth by these presence  
 Covenant grant and forever Warrant and Defend the said granted Lots
